Contains 23% inhibited hydrochloric acid and specially selected detergents to quickly and completely attack the most stubborn deposits. The special inhibitors protect plumbing once soils are flushed away.

**DIRECTIONS:** FOR USE INSIDE TOILET BOWLS AND URINALS ONLY. WEAR RUBBER GLOVES, AND GOGGLES OR FACE SHIELD AT ALL TIMES. DO NOT USE ON MARBLE, TERRAZZO, STAINLESS STEEL, CHROME, ALUMINUM OR PLASTICS. SPOT TEST ON UNKNOWN SURFACES.

- For cleaning toilet bowls and urinals:* Flush toilet and use swab mop to push water from the bowl over trap. Press swab mop against bowl to remove excess water, then saturate mop with bowl cleaner while holding bottle and applicator over bowl. Swab bowl or urinal completely, making sure to get under the rim. Let stand 10 minutes then flush. Rinse applicator completely.

**Effects of Overexposure**  
**Skin:** Severe skin irritant. Prolonged or repeated contact will cause permanent chemical burns.

**Protective Gloves:** full arm length acid-proof rubber, or neoprene  
**Eye Protection:** goggles with side shield and full face shield,  
**Other Protective Equipment:** Eyewash station nearby, chemical resistant apron should be worn when danger of splash contact will occur.

**Cleanup Procedure for Spills:** Immediately evacuate all unessential personnel from area. Ventilate area well. Acquire special protection equipment as noted in Section 8. Absorb spill with inert material. Neutralize with soda ash or lime. Avoid discharge to sewer or open waterways.
