DESCRIPTION: PRIDE'S Carpet Shampoo is a superior bonnet cleaning concentrate that dissolves water and oil-based soils on contact, allowing them to be absorbed into the bonnet for fast and efficient removal. Leaves the carpet bright and smelling cherry fresh just minutes after cleaning, especially for those high traffic areas that need to be reopened quick.

DIRECTIONS:

- Be sure to vacuum carpet thoroughly. Spot clean as needed. Two methods of bonnet cleaning can be attained by using Carpet Shampoo:
1. Dilute 1 part concentrate to 16 parts water (8 ozs. per gallon) and add to a pump up sprayer. Pre-spray the carpet and the pad. Buff the treated carpet from side to side using overlapping circular motions. As the pad becomes soiled, change pads or thoroughly rinse the pad in a bucket of clean water, wring it out and continue. (Please note that this method allows for greater moisture control and quicker dry time.)
 2. Dilute 1 part concentrate to 16 parts water (8 ozs. per gallon) in a clean bucket. Have another bucket available with clean water for rinsing. Submerge pad into diluted solution, remove and wring out tightly. Buff carpet from side to side using overlapping circular motions. As the pad becomes soiled, change pads or thoroughly rinse the pad in a bucket of clean water, wring it out and continue. (Please note that this method cleans better, however, it gets the carpet much wetter thus requiring longer drying time.)
